<u>CURRENT MILITARY GRADE REQUIREMENTS:</u> All qualified Missouri National Guard members in the rank of Captain through Major.	
<u>APPLICANTS MUST AT APPLICATION TIME:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be able to pass the Standard Army Physical Fitness Test (APFT). 2. Meet physical standards IAW Chapter 3, AR 40-501 (Retention Standards). Must meet height and weight standards of AR 600-9. Must be medically certified as drug free and test negative for HIV in accordance with AR 40-501 and AR 600-110. Females who are NOT currently members of the Army National Guard must not be pregnant in accordance with AR 40-501 and AR 600-110. Must have current MOS Medical Retention Board (MMRB) if required. 3. Must already possess a SECRET clearance. 4. Not have any unfavorable personnel actions pending (Flagged), IAW AR 600-8-2 and AR 135-18. 5. Not have a temporary profile IAW ARNG-HRH PPOM #13-020. 	
<u>DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:</u> To serve as the OIC (Officer in Charge) for the HRF Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear Task Force Mission Command (CBRN TF MC) and subordinate elements. Oversees, manages, and monitors all administrative, training, and logistical requirements for the CBRN TF and subordinate elements, ensuring that each element maintains a readiness posture exceeding the standards directed by NGB and the HRF MC. Develops and plans collective training events and associated venues in accordance with the Commander's intent and as directed by the HRF MC and NGB. Develops Yearly Planning Guidance (YPG) for subordinate elements in accordance with Commander's intent, HRF MC and NGB guidance. Provides programmatic oversight and resource management for all aspects of the CBRN TF and subordinate elements and alerts the CBRN TF Commander to factors that may impact the unit's ability to respond to an incident within prescribed timelines. Ensures that the CBRN TF and subordinate elements are in compliance with SEAT standards and that all members of the CBRN TF and subordinate elements Joint Manning Documents have the knowledge, in accordance with prescribed T&EO's, to exceed EXEVAL requirements and excel in the execution of real-world missions.

INDIVIDUALS MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- 1. DA FORM 1058-R-** Soldier MUST sign blocks 21 and 23. Commander signs block 34e and records custodian must complete block 35a-d.
- 2. TOUR ANNOUNCEMENT-** FTNGD-OS tour announcement for which the application is for.
- 3. Copy of DA Form 705 for last 3 APFT (Army Physical Fitness Test Score Card) -** the latest PASSED and FOR RECORD APFT must have been taken within the past 12 months for the application and if selected the APFT date must be within 6 months of start date.
- 4. Copy of DA Form 2-1 (Personnel Qualification Record) or ERB/ORB.**
- 5. Copy of MEDPROS-** Individual Medical Readiness Record displaying evidence of: Periodic Health Assessment completed with-in 12 months and HIV with-in last 2 years. (HIV Draw can be done after interview and selection). Medical documentation other than MEDPROS will not be accepted and will cause the application to be immediately destroyed.
- 6. Copy of your DA Form 3349 (Physical Profile) and MOS Medical Retention Board (MMRB) results (if applicable).**
- 7. Height/Weight Memo from unit-** Additionally a copy of the last 2 DA Form 5500-R (Body Fat Worksheet) if applicable.
- 8. Copies of the last (3) NCOERs or OERs.** If 3 are not available a statement your first line supervisor attesting to your character of service is required. **If E4 and below a statement from your first line supervisor and from a member of your chain of command attesting to your character of service is required (total of 2).
- 9. NGB Form 23 (Retirement Point Summary) and/or a Statement of Service within 12 months.** Also include copies of all DD Form 214s and NGB Form 22s if applicable.
- 10. Military Biography**
- 11. Memorandum For Record from unit** stating current security clearance (JPAS is not accepted).
- 12. Memorandum to the hiring board.** Memorandum will include current mailing and telephonic contact information at a minimum. It may include specific qualifications that would be beneficial to this position that the applicant would like to highlight. This memorandum must be dated and signed.

If you are unable to provide any of the documents above, a memorandum must be submitted explaining why that document is not available.
