MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION A & I

SUBJECT: Traditional Position Announcement with HHD 229TH MEDICAL BATTALION, Jefferson City, MO (SWVA #17-0626)

1. HHD 229TH MEDICAL BATTALION, Jefferson City, MO has a vacant 68R40, VET SVC NCO position (Para/Line 108/02). The current EPS list has been exhausted and the position is now open statewide.
2. A 68R40, Veterinary Food Inspection Specialist supervise medium sized or combined veterinary service unit. Coordinates transportation, administration, and logistical support of food inspectors and animal care specialists assigned to local activities and at remote sites. Develops, evaluates, and directs individual and collective training programs. Reviews, analyzes, consolidates and prepares food defense inspection/assessment technical reports as required using the Food Defense database system. Reviews and updates publications. Prepares and reviews correspondence. Serve as advisor to veterinary officer in developing food product quality assurance programs. Supports a variety of administrative and programs related ancillary duties associated with installation and MSC operations,
3. **MOS requirements:** A physical demands rating of Moderate (Gold). A physical profile of 222221. Normal color vision and good near vision. Possession of normal olfactory senses. Per AR 600-8-19, promotion to MSG and SGM requires an interim eligibility clearance or higher. Qualifying scores. A minimum score of 100 in aptitude area ST in Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of 96 in aptitude area ST on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002 and prior to 1 July 2004. A minimum score of 95 in aptitude area ST on ASVAB tests administered on and after 1 July 2004. A minimum OPAT score of Standing Long Jump (LJ) – 0120 cm, Seated Power Throw (PT) – 0350 cm, Strength Deadlift (SD) – 0120 lbs., and Interval Aerobic Run (IR) – 0036 shuttles in Physical Demand Category in "Moderate" (Gold). High school diploma or GED with credit for general science, or mathematics with a "C" grade or higher or numerical grade of 74% or higher. Applicants with a GED must score 45 or higher on the GED Test 5 to satisfy the math requirements. The Soldier requires a Secret clearance at grade E5 or above. (Effective 1 October 2014). A security eligibility of SECRET is required for the initial award and to maintain the MOS. Requirements for an eligibility of SECRET clearance is effective 1 October 2015 for all new accessions and reclassifications into MOS 68R. Requirement for an eligibility of SECRET clearance is

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effective 1 October 2015 for all Soldiers maintaining MOS 68R who entered service prior to 1 October 2014. Possess a valid state motor vehicle operator's license. No history of a felony conviction. No history of conviction of crimes involving: Any weapons/ammunition/explosives/arson charges. Any drug activity involving illegal possession, buying, selling or distribution (dealing) of controlled substances or synthetics. Violence against persons or property. Sexual misconduct.

4. Select Reserve Bonus Consideration: Any change in a Soldier's MOS, except as provided by normal rank progression as outlined in DA PAM 611-21, is not allowed and will terminate that Soldier's Select Reserve Incentive Program bonus, with recoupment. Accepting a SWVA slot is voluntary change of MOS and falls outside of normal rank progression. Please consult your bonus contract and the Education & Incentives office at State if you have any questions.

5. Who May Apply: Current MOARNG Soldiers in grades E5 through E7 in any MOS, and E7 Active Army and USAR Soldiers who currently hold the 68R MOS.

a. Any Soldier who is on the current EPS list with a different CPMOS that is eligible to reclass. Upon completion of MOS training, the Soldier may be promoted if they continue to meet eligibility requirements for the next higher grade.

b. Any Soldier who is not on the current EPS list, transfer into the para/line is authorized. Upon completion of the requirements for promotion (MOSQ, NCOES, TIG, TIS), all pertinent information will be sent to NGMO-PER-AB for the next scheduled EPS Board or STAB. Once the Soldier appears on the EPS list, a request for promotion can be submitted. See the MOARNG 2017 EPS MOI, dated 29 September 2016.
