MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION A & I

SUBJECT: Traditional Position Announcement with **CO A(ASC) 1107TH AVN GRP TASMG, Springfield, MO (SWVA #17-0659)**

- 1. CO A(ASC) 1107TH AVN GRP TASMG, Springfield, MO** has a vacant **15T20, UH-60 REP/TM CH** position (Para/Line **207/04**). The current EPS list has been exhausted and the position is now open statewide.
- 2. A 15T20, UH-60 Helicopter Repairer** Performs and installs aircraft subsystem assemblies such as engines, rotors, gearboxes, transmissions, mechanical flight controls and their components. Services and lubricates aircraft and subsystems. Prepare aircraft for inspections and maintenance checks. Performs scheduled inspections and assists in performing special inspections. Performs limited maintenance operational checks and assists in diagnosing and troubleshooting aircraft subsystems using special tools and equipment as required. Requisitions and maintains shop and bench stock for repair of aircraft systems and equipment. Maintains facilities for storage of flammable and hazardous materials. Uses and performs operator maintenance on tools, special tools and aircraft ground support equipment. Prepares forms and records related to aircraft maintenance. Performs non-rated crewmember duties. Provides technical guidance to subordinate personnel. Performs operational checks and scheduled inspections. Diagnoses and troubleshoots malfunctions in aircraft subsystems. Conducts flight and academic instruction in accordance with Aircrew Training Program (ATP). Monitor hazardous material control and storage
- 3. MOS requirements:** A physical demands rating of Significant (Gray). A physical profile of 222211. Normal color vision. Qualifying scores. A minimum score of 105 in aptitude area MM in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of 102 in aptitude area MM on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002 and prior to 1 July 2004. A minimum score of 104 in aptitude area MM on ASVAB tests administered on and after 1 July 2004. A Minimum OPAT score of Standing Long Jump (LJ) -0140 cm, Seated Power Throw (PT) - 0400 cm, Strength Deadlift (SD) - 0140 lbs., and Interval Aerobic Run (IR) - 0040 shuttles in Physical Demands Category "Significant" (Gray). Formal training (completion of a resident MOS 15T course conducted under the auspices of The United States Army Aviation Center of Excellence (USAACE) or meet the ACASP criteria per paragraph 9-5b (5)(b) of this pamphlet and in paragraph (h) below. ACASP qualification criteria. Must have 2 years experience, or combination of formal training, and experience totaling 2 years in the repair of Sikorsky Model S-70 and S-76

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helicopters. Reclassification: Must meet the above qualifications and all prerequisites IAW AR 614-200 Chapter 3-19 and AR 40-501 Chapter 3. Must be in the grade of SPC (non-promotable) or below unless they have held an aviation maintenance/component repairer CMF 15 MOS for a minimum of 12 months at skill level 1 or 2, 18 months at skill level 3 or 24 months at skill level 4.

**4. Select Reserve Bonus Consideration:** Any change in a Soldier's MOS, except as provided by normal rank progression as outlined in DA PAM 611-21, is not allowed and will terminate that Soldier's Select Reserve Incentive Program bonus, with recoupment. Accepting an SWVA slot is a voluntary change of MOS and falls outside of normal rank progression. Please consult your bonus contract and the Education & Incentives office at State if you have any questions.

**5. Who May Apply:** Current MOARNG Soldiers in grades E3 through E5 in any MOS, and E5 Active Army and USAR Soldiers who currently hold the 15T MOS.


a. Any Soldier who is on the current EPS list with a different CPMOS that is eligible to reclass. Upon completion of MOS training, the Soldier may be promoted if they continue to meet eligibility requirements for the next higher grade.

b. Any Soldier who is not on the current EPS list, transfer into the para/line is authorized. Upon completion of the requirements for promotion (MOSQ, NCOES, TIG, TIS), all pertinent information will be sent to NGMO-PER-AB for the next scheduled EPS Board or STAB. Once the Soldier appears on the EPS list, a request for promotion can be submitted. See the MOARNG 2017 EPS MOI, dated 29 September 2016.
