MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION A & I

SUBJECT: Traditional Position Announcement with **MAIN CMD POST OPERATIONAL DET, Lamar, MO (SWVA #17-0688)**

1. **MAIN CMD POST OPERATIONAL DET, Lamar, MO** has a vacant **13F40, FIRE SUPPORT NCO** position (Para/Line **115/01**). The current EPS list has been exhausted and the position is now open statewide.

2. A **13F40, Fire Support Specialist** leads and trains the Fire Support Elements and FECC of the Fires Brigade Tactical Operations Center (TOC) or the FSE at battalion or higher levels during combat operations. Advises and assists fire support sergeants of subordinate elements in fire planning and coordination techniques. Drafts fire support plans for tactical operations orders and plans. Coordinates plans for company, battalion, and brigade fire support and integrates them with the overall scheme of maneuver. Recommends the employment of fire support means to include naval gunfire and close air support. Recommend employment of target acquisition assets and target selection standards. Assists in target analysis and fire planning at the Maneuver Battalion, Fires Brigade, Division and Corps or higher FSE/FECC. Supervise the performance of operator, crew and organizational maintenance on section vehicles.

3. **MOS requirements:** A physical demands rating of Heavy (Black). A physical profile of 111111. Normal color vision. Qualifying scores. A minimum score of 100 in aptitude area FA in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of 96 in aptitude area FA on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002. A minimum OPAT score of Standing Long Jump (LJ) – 0160 cm, Seated Power Throw (PT) – 0450 cm, Strength Deadlift (SD) – 0160 lbs., and Interval Aerobic Run (IR) – 0043 shuttles in Physical Demand Category in "Heavy" (Black). All Soldiers must possess a SECRET security eligibility for the initial award and to maintain the MOS. Requirements for a SECRET eligibility is effective 01 October 2013 for all new accessions and reclassifications into MOS 13F. Requirements for a SECRET eligibility is effective 01 October 2016 for all Soldiers in MOS 13F who entered service prior to 01 October 2013. Formal training under the auspices of USAFAS or accredited ARNG RTI transition course is mandatory to qualify for the award of the MOS. The highest grade for personnel seeking reclassification into MOS 13F without a waiver is a non-promotable E4 (SPC/CPL). Personnel reclassifying into MOS 13F must successfully complete institutional training at a MOS 13F OASS compliant, accredited ARNG RTI transition course (preferred), or MOS 13F AIT at USAFAS. Personnel in grades E5 SGT (P) and E6 SSG must submit a waiver to ATTN:

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Commandant, USAFAS, Fort Sill, OK, 73503 for determination of eligibility to reclassify into MOS 13F. Personnel at the rank of Sergeant First Class (E7) are not authorized for reclassification into MOS 13F. A U.S. citizen.

4. Select Reserve Bonus Consideration: Any change in a Soldier's MOS, except as provided by normal rank progression as outlined in DA PAM 611-21, is not allowed and will terminate that Soldier's Select Reserve Incentive Program bonus, with recoupment. Accepting a SWVA slot is voluntary change of MOS and falls outside of normal rank progression. Please consult your bonus contract and the Education & Incentives office at State if you have any questions.

5. Who May Apply: Current MOARNG Soldiers in grades E5 through E7 in any MOS, and E7 Active Army and USAR Soldiers who currently hold the 13F MOS.

a. Any Soldier who is on the current EPS list with a different CPMOS that is eligible to reclass. Upon completion of MOS training, the Soldier may be promoted if they continue to meet eligibility requirements for the next higher grade.


b. Any Soldier who is not on the current EPS list, transfer into the para/line is authorized. Upon completion of the requirements for promotion (MOSQ, NCOES, TIG, TIS), all pertinent information will be sent to NGMO-PER-AB for the next scheduled EPS Board or STAB. Once the Soldier appears on the EPS list, a request for promotion can be submitted. See the MOARNG 2017 EPS MOI, dated 29 September 2016.
