MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION A & I

SUBJECT: Traditional Position Announcement with CO A(ASC) 1107TH AVN GRP TASMG, Springfield, MO (SWVA #17-0750)

1. CO A(ASC) 1107TH AVN GRP TASMG, Springfield, MO has a vacant 88N20, MOVEMENTS NCO position (Para/Line 220/05). The current EPS list has been exhausted and the position is now open statewide.
2. A 88N20, **Transportation Management Coordinator** provides supervision and technical guidance for subordinates. Researches, interprets, prepares and coordinates actions pertaining to travel entitlements. Function as the customs officer for shipment releases in overseas theaters. Operate as quality control NCO for commercial movement contracts. Monitors all freight, cargo and materiel shipments to ensure accountability; identifies and reports problem areas within the traffic management system to prevent additional costs, losses and damage. Conduct briefings for unit moves. Requests, coordinates and monitors movement schedules and programs; ensures transport capability is appropriate, cost effective and meets mission requirements. Checks and inspects equipment blocking and bracing. Prepares and consolidates transportation movement reports. Operates automated data processing equipment to document movement information, conducts research, monitors movements, inspects commercial contracts and responds to shipment inquiries, discrepancies and routine movements transactions.
3. **MOS requirements:** A physical demands rating of heavy. A physical profile of 222222. Normal color vision based on no more than four errors in reading the pseudo isochromatic plates test. A security eligibility of SECRET. All MOS 88N personnel require a SECRET security eligibility. All new non-prior service accessions and in-service reclassifications into MOS 88N require a SECRET security eligibility. U.S. citizenship. All MOS 88N personnel are required to be a US citizen. All new non-prior service accessions and in-service reclassifications into MOS 88N are required to be a US citizen. Qualifying scores. A minimum score of 100 in aptitude area CL in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of 97 in aptitude area CL on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002 and prior to 1 July 2004. A minimum score of 95 in aptitude area CL on ASVAB tests administered on and after 1 July 2004.

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4. **Select Reserve Bonus Consideration:** Any change in a Soldier's MOS, except as provided by normal rank progression as outlined in DA PAM 611-21, is not allowed and will terminate that Soldier's Select Reserve Incentive Program bonus, with recoupment. Accepting an SWVA slot is a voluntary change of MOS and falls outside of normal rank progression. Please consult your bonus contract and the Education & Incentives office at State if you have any questions.

5. **Who May Apply:** Current MOARNG Soldiers in grades E3 to E5 in any MOS, and E5 Active Army and USAR Soldiers who are 88N MOS qualified.


a. Any Soldier who is on the current EPS list with a different CPMOS that is eligible to reclass. Upon completion of MOS training, the Soldier may be promoted if they continue to meet eligibility requirements for the next higher grade.

b. Any Soldier who is not on the current EPS list, transfer into the para/line is authorized. Upon completion of the requirements for promotion (MOSQ, NCOES, TIG, TIS), all pertinent information will be sent to NGMO-PER-AB for the next scheduled EPS Board or STAB. Once the Soldier appears on the EPS list, a request for promotion can be submitted. See the MOARNG 2017 EPS MOI, dated 29 September 2016.
