These World War I medals were authorized by an April 23, 1919 Act of the Missouri General Assembly. They were made of bronze and silk by D.L Auld Company the cost was about 25 cents each. The medal you will be receiving is the original medal that was struck back in the early 1920's and not a reproduction. This having been said we cannot guarantee the condition or quality of the medals or packaging.

NOTE: THERE ARE ONLY APPROXIMATELY 1500 OF THESE MEDALS REMAINING, ONCE THESE MEDALS HAVE BEEN AWARDED THE WORLD WAR I PROGRAM WILL END. THEY WILL BE AWARDED ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE, AS IS BASIS UNTIL THE SUPPLY IS EXHAUSTED.

Instructions for Completion of the War Medallion Program Application Form

1. Who may apply:

- a. Eldest living family member.

Eligibility Requirements: U.S. Forces Medal

- a. Veteran must have served on active duty in the United States military service between 6 April 1917 and 11 November 1918.
- b. Veteran was a legal resident of Missouri when he or she entered military service.
- c. Veteran received an honorable discharge.
- d. The War medallion, medal, and certificate shall be awarded regardless of whether or not such veteran served within the United States or in a foreign country.

Eligibility Requirement: National Guard Missouri Medal

- a. Member of the National Guard Missouri who served on active duty in the United States military service between 5 August 1917 and 11 November 1918.
- b. Veteran was a legal resident of Missouri when he or she entered military service.
- c. Veteran received an honorable discharge.
- d. The War medallion, medal, and certificate shall be awarded regardless of whether or not such veteran served within the United States or in a foreign country

3. **Service Information:** It is very **important** to fill out this section as completely as possible.
4. **Veteran eligibility** will be determined by use of the Secretary of State's digitized Soldiers War Records of World War I. **If we are unable to verify eligibility the applicant will be required to provide proof (i.e. copies of military records, official documents, county records, obituaries, newspaper clippings, etc.)**
